

**Anthony F. Buono** has a joint appointment as Professor of Management and Sociology at Bentley University and is Founding Coordinator of the Bentley Alliance for Ethics and Social Responsibility. He is also a former Chair of Bentley's Management Department.

Tony has written or edited eleven books including *The Human Side of Mergers and Acquisitions* (1989, 2003), *A Primer on Organizational Behavior* (7<sup>th</sup> ed., 2008), *Corporate Policy, Values and Social Responsibility* (1985), *Challenges and Issues in Knowledge Management* (2005), and, most recently, *Socio-Economic Intervention in Organizations* (2007) and *Emerging Trends and Issues in Management Consulting* (2009). He is also editor of the *Research in Management Consulting* book series. His articles and review essays appear in *Academy of Management Learning & Education*, *Across the Board*, *Administrative Science Quarterly*, *Business & Society Review*, *Business & the Contemporary World*, *Consultation*, *Human Relations*, *Human Resource Planning*, *Journal of Management Education*, *Journal of Organizational Change Management*, *Journal of Public Service & Outreach*, *Leadership Quarterly*, *Management Decision*, *Organization Development Journal*, *Personnel Psychology*, *Research on Corporate Social Policy and Performance*, *Revue Sciences de Gestion*, *SAM Advanced Management Journal* and *Symphonya*, as well as numerous edited volumes.

He is a past chair of the Academy of Management's Management Consulting Division, a Research Fellow with Bentley's Center for Business Ethics, and has received Bentley's highest honors for both teaching and research. Tony's research and consulting focus on organizational change, interorganizational strategies, ethics and corporate responsibilities, and firm-stakeholder relationships. Over the past 25 years, he has also been an active consultant to numerous organizations and professional associations. As part of his Alliance responsibilities, he chairs Bentley's Institutional Review Board (IRB) and is a member of the College-wide Ethics Committee, and serves on the Advisory Boards for Bentley's Service-Learning Center, Cronin International Center, Women's Leadership Institute, and the Academic Integrity System. He is also a Research Fellow with Bentley's Center for Business Ethics.

Tony has also been an invited visiting scholar with the Binational Fulbright Commission for Educational & Cultural Exchange in Cairo, Egypt, at the University of Tallinn and Tartu University in Estonia, and, most recently, at the University of Lyon (Universite Jean Moulin Lyon 3), the Copenhagen Business School, and Benedictine University. He holds a B.S. in Business Administration from the University of Maryland, and an M.A. and Ph.D. with a concentration in Industrial and Organizational Sociology from Boston College.
